For efficient operation of national conformity assessment system, a group of representative composed of working-level staffs in four departments visited accreditation bodies in Hong Kong (HKAS) and Germany (DAkkS) in order to analyze best practices and operation status of overseas accreditation bodies and to find measures for building a cooperation system.





At the Hong Kong Accreditation Service (HKAS), discussion was carried out with authorities on accreditation system, overall management techniques, and background and operation status of ISO 15189 accreditation system currently being promoted as an official accreditation program by KOLAS.





At DAkkS, which is the leading AB that had unified the systems of 4 ABs, we had an opportunity to discuss unification background, EU Regulation No. 765/2008, changes in operation system after unification and problems caused by unification, finding directivity for domestic unification policy.

Data collected from joint visiting program among different departments will be reflected in establishment of national single accreditation body that encompasses all departments. Cooperation system among departments and plans to promote efficient conformity assessment system will be prepared.



In an effort to settle official accreditation program for ISO 15189, 「KOLAS Medical Testing Policy Meeting was held on October 28, 2011 at Seoul Education and Culture Hall for sharing and discussion of policy.

This meeting was proceeded with participation by relevant societies, experts on conformity assessment and KOLAS employees to share and discuss information on international trend of medical testing, preparation for transition of official accreditation, surveillance activities, proficiency testing and future policy directions.



Based on the opinions deduced from the meeting, solutions will be prepared through follow-up reviews by relevant committees and departments ministries.

■ On-site Assessment of MASM Mass Lab

As a part of assistance programs for developing countries by UNIDO, KOLAS conducted on-site assessment of Mass Lab at MASM for accreditation of calibration laboratory from November 23 to 24, 2011.

Assessment team was composed of three experts including witnessing by KOLAS staff for assessment of quality system, employee competence and mass lab capability.



Corrective actions are being carried out by the applicant on the findings raised.

■ Status of Proficiency Testing Programs Organized by KOLAS in 2011

A total of 23 proficiency testing programs with 12 in testing and 11 in calibration were organized in 2011, according to the Article 27 of KOLAS-R-001:2011 and Article 26 of KOLAS-R-002:2011 regarding proficiency testing. The results and progress status are as follows:

■ ISO 13528 APLAC Training Course on Statistical Methods for PT

TISO 13528 APLAC Training Course, organized by APLAC for PT experts was held at New Delhi, India from October 11 to 13, 2011. A PT expert from proficiency testing provider (Korea Testing Laboratory, Researcher Maeng, Geun Ho) participated as the Korean representative.



*ISO 13528: Statistical methods for use proficiency testing by interlaboratory comparisons

This training course was newly established upon request by participants of proficiency training to promote better understanding of statistical methods for proficiency testing based on ISO 13528 and ISO/IEC 17043 and to attract development of proficiency testing programs in Asia-Pacific region. In addition, this course was established for promotion of APLAC MRA on accreditation of PT providers through application of internationally harmonized statistical method.

With training by experts for standards regarding statistical methods in proficiency testing, discussion was made on statistical requirements in PT related to ISO/IEC 17043 and ISO 13528. Finally, the course was completed with planning of proficiency testing, design method and practicing of design.

KOLAS will spread the results of training to KOLAS-accredited organizations including proficiency testing providers through refresher training and technical committee meeting.

■ Participation in the 27th ISO/CASCO Plenary Meeting in Switzerland

The 27th ISO/CASCO Plenary Meeting paralleled with workshop was held at Geneva, Switzerland from October 5 to 7, 2011.

About 100 participants attended this meeting from 34 national standardization bodies and 24 liaison organizations. Including ISO liaison officer and employee, the Director of Conformity Policy Division participated in the meeting as a delegation from Korea.



At the CASCO Open Day Workshop, exemplary cases for establishment and operation of National Mirror Committee were discussed to encourage relevant institutions for effective operation. In the second session, discussion was focused on ISO/IEC 17021 currently being drafted by ISO/CASCO WG 21.

■ Joint declaration signed by BIPM, OIML, ILAC and ISO on metrological traceability

BIPM, OIML, ILAC and ISO signed the joint declaration on metrological traceability on November 9, 2011.

The four international organizations approved of the following:

- In order to rely on international acceptability of the four organizations, calibrations should be performed:
- ▶ in National Metrology Institutes who should normally be signatories to the CIPM MRA and have CMCs published in the relevant areas of the KCDB or
 - in laboratories accredited by accreditation bodies which are signatories to the ILAC Arrangement;
- measurement uncertainty should follow the principles established in the GUM;
- the results of the measurements made in accredited laboratories should be traceable to the SI;
- NMIs providing traceability for accredited laboratories should normally be signatories to the CIPM MRA and



bave CMCs published in the relevant areas of the KCDB;

• within the OIML's MAA, accreditation should be provided by bodies which are signatories to the ILAC Arrangement and the above policies on traceability to the SI should be followed;

The above principles should be used whenever there is a need to demonstrate metrological traceability or international acceptability.
